

GUIDED STREEDAGH WALK WITH AURIEL ROBINSON, SEATRAILS UNDER PEACE III PROJECT

Sunday, 27th of July; 1.30pm

Meet at the Armada Memorial (on the way towards Streedagh Beach on right before you cross the cattle grid). Please park after cattle grid. During the walk, Auriel will discuss the history of how three ships became wrecked here in 1588, the sites relating to the wreckage & sites relating to Captain Francisco de Cuellar & his escape, such as Staad & Ahamlish church/abbey sites, the lay of the land & seascape at Streedagh, (including Inishmurray & Donegal Bay) & what ancient maps tell us. The plan is to walk from the monument to Trawgar beach, then up through the dunes to the rocky slab (west side) and then return through dunes to memorial. It will probably take over 1.5 hrs.
