Saints that have raised images/effigy on all the cannons

St Sebastian (died c. 288) was an early martyr and according to Christian belief, he was killed during the Roman emperor Diocletian's persecution of Christians. He is commonly depicted in art and literature tied to a post or tree and shot with arrows. Despite this being the most common artistic depiction of Sebastian, he was, according to legend, rescued and healed by Irene of Rome.



St. Peter Cannon whose image holding the keys of the Kingdom. "I give you the keys of the Kingdom of heaven, whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven". St Matrona, San Jionni,

St Rocho Cannon: Patron Saint of Dogs; a dog licked his wounds and miraculously cured him of the plague

St Ilaria Cannon: 4th century Saint of Roman origin and martyred in Spain, burnt at the stake (always depicted with an 'X' cross).

St. John the Baptist: beheaded because he upset Herod 's 2nd wife and in his drunken state conceded to her request
