**RELICS OF ST ANTHONY OF PADUA**

**CATHEDRAL OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SUNDAY JUNE 12<sup>th</sup>**

**12 noon - 7:00 P.M.**

St Anthony, one of the earliest members of the Franciscan Order and much loved saint of lost things, will be visiting our Cathedral in the form of two relics, one of which is the one Pope Francis venerated sixteen years ago in Argentina. Earlier, in 1995, during the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St Anthony's birth, the relics travelled also to Portugal and were received by Sister Lucia, one of the three seers of Fatima, in the Carmelite Convent in Coimbra. Known for helping people find lost items, Saint Anthony also intercedes with those trying to find a job, a home, faith, love, hope and mercy. The relics will be accompanied in Ireland by Father Mario Conte, editor of the *Messenger of St Anthony*, the magazine published by the Conventual Franciscan Friars of Saint Anthony's Basilica in Padua, Italy, where the Saint's tomb is located.

**The relics will remain exposed during 12 noon and 7:00 p.m. Masses with Veneration ALL DAY after 12 noon Mass.**
