Appointed Curate to Loughglynn/Gorthaganny from 1968 to 1971; St. Mary's Sligo 1971 to 1980. Volunteer work on Missions with Kiltegan Fathers in Kenya 1980 to 1985. Curate to St. John's, Lecarrow from July 1985 to 1991, subsequently Parish Priest to Ballagh 1993 to 1997. Currently Parish Priest of Castlerea since August, 1997.

Fr. John Joe Gannon - Born in Aughrim, Co. Roscommon. Educated in Summerhill college, Sligo and St. Patrick's College, Maynooth. Ordained on the 19th June, 1966 in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Sligo. Further studies in U.C.C (H.Dip. Ed. 1966 to 1967 and B. Mus. 1967 to 1969).
