

**Fr. John Sullivan S.J.**

On May 13<sup>th</sup> this year, the Beatification Ceremony of Blessed John Sullivan took place in Gardiner St. Church – the first ever to take place in Ireland. His remains lie in a shrine in the same church, where people have long since come to pray and bring their petitions. Blessed John was baptised an Anglican and has left behind the memory of a life dedicated to the sick and poor in Co. Kildare, and of prayer practiced regularly and deeply. He grew up in an affluent Dublin family. Educated at Portara College, Enniskillen and Trinity College, Dublin, graduating with a classics degree. Moving to London, he became a barrister but never practiced. A deep religious thinker, he finally entered the Catholic Church in December 1891, aged 36. In 1900, he entered the Jesuits and was ordained in 1907. He taught and lived in Clongowes Wood College until he died on Feb 19<sup>th</sup> 1933, where he is buried in the community Cemetery until his exhumation in 1960 on the presumption of outstanding holiness and brought to the chapel of the Sacred Heart in the large city centre Church of Saint Francis Xavier, Gardener St., Dublin.

Students nicknamed him Johnny O and after he died, one student said to his mother “it’s unusual to know you have been taught by a saint”. He cared for the sick, cycling to homes, hovels, hospitals to pray for and with them.

Choosing a simple life, he challenges us to choose the path of loving rather than greed. Beatification! A title which indicated his heroic living of the following of Christ and a unity with Christ beyond the ordinary.

**Fr. Edward J. Flanagan**

Founder of Boystown, Nebraska, USA, a native of Ballymoe, Co. Galway and educated at Summerhill College, Sligo. The Cause for his Canonisation has completed its second phase. His story and history was accumulated over the past few years and sent to Rome by our diocese. That history has been examined in Rome and we have now received a letter of acceptance by Rome of the information we gave recently.
