#### Mighty Mona strikes gold for Ireland

Well done to Mona McSharry who won gold in the 50m breaststroke on Wednesday at the 2017 European Junior Swim Championships in Israel. Not only did Mona win gold for Ireland but she also cracked the Irish junior record with a new time of 31.14 and the previous senior national record of 30.93 held by Fiona Doyle. Mona now holds the Irish Senior Record for 50m breastroke in a time of 30.91. With Mona's gold medal victory tonight, she becomes the first teenage Irish swimmer to have won gold at a European Junior Championships since recently retired Sycerika McMahon clinched a 50m breaststroke/400m freestyle golden combo back in 2011. Mona is also swimming in the 200m breaststroke on Thursday. Mona then went on to win silver in the 200m breaststroke on Thursday and smashed the Junior and Senior record by setting a new senior Irish record of 2.27.44 for this distance.

Mona now races in the 100m breaststroke on Saturday - watch this space.
Fantastic performance from Christopher O'Donnell, North Sligo Athletics
Christopher O'Donnell, who is still only 19 years old, was selected to race in the senior 4 x 400 m relay team in European Team Championships in Finland last weekend. He raced the first leg for the team which also included Brian Gregan, Thomas Barr and Mark English.
Christopher put the team in first place at the end of his first leg handing the baton to Thomas Barr. In the end they won 2nd place just being beaten on the line by Belgium. Well done Ireland and well done Christopher.
