Congrats to all members of the Association who were awarded "The Plate of the order of Isabel La Católica", on 25<sup>th</sup> Aug at City Hall, Sligo by the Spanish Ambassador to Ireland Jose Maria Rodriguez – Coso. The award is the highest Spanish civil order granted in recognition of people/ associations that have provided services to Spain.
