Congrats to all members of the Association who were awarded "The Plate of the order of Isabel La Católica", on 25th Aug at City Hall, Sligo by the Spanish Ambassador to Ireland Jose Maria Rodriguez – Coso. The award is the highest Spanish civil order granted in recognition of people/ associations that have provided services to Spain. This is the first time that the award has been granted to a group in Ireland, recognising the work of GADA in engaging with Spanish Armada history. Congratulations & welcome home to our very own World Champion, Mona McSharry.

Mona McSharry made history in Indianapolis on Saturday, 25th August 2017 when she became the first ever Irish swimmer to win gold at the World Junior Swimming Championships.

Mona was victorious in the 100 metres breaststroke, breaking the national senior record as she touched the wall in 1:07.10 to beat Canadian favourite Faith Nelson. Racing to the championship title and gold medal Mona eclipsed Fiona Doyle's 2015 Irish Record of 1:07.15 by five hundredths of a second winning in 1:07.10, knocking almost three tenths of a second off her own previous best of 1:07.38 from this year's Irish Open Swimming Championships.

Doyle's time was her qualification for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.

Mona had earlier won a bronze medal in the 50 metres breaststroke and came 4th in the 200m breaststroke on Monday evening.

In the past 8 weeks, Mona has won World and European 100m Breaststroke Gold, World Bronze and European Gold in the 50m Breaststroke and European 200m Breaststroke Silver. Congratulations Mona to you and your family. We are delighted that all your hard work and dedication and the support of your family has reaped such fantastic rewards.
