Prisoners Sun 12th Nov

Remembering prisoners this Sunday, why? As a Christian what is your response to evil in the world. "Lock them up + throw away the key" – "Execute!" Reform! Rehabilitate! The church has always had outreach to prisoners and even more importantly to their families. Family is important to us all, but even more so to people in prison. When people in prison keep close ties with their families, they are much less likely to reoffend. When you have a problem or want to share important news, it is family you think of first. There is an unconditional love within the family; they (almost) always forgive. It is a fantastic support structure. The hardship of families dealing with a family member in prison is conveyed well in "EVERYDAY" a film by Michael Winterbottom. Most people in prison are not dangerous, they are sent by the courts who deemed it necessary to impose a custodial sentence but their families have done nothing wrong, yet experience massive hardship, including shame and isolation and for children the loss of a parent. How can we make a more perfect response to imprisonment? Our challenge is to live the gospel. "I was in prison and you came to see me" Matt 25:36. As we prepare to celebrate the World Meeting of Families next year, we need to include all families, especially those separated from each other.
