The Beneficiation of Irish American

Capuchin Friar Blessed Solanus Casey took place at Ford Field, Detroit, USA, attended by 60,000 people + 500 concelebrating priests. His parents Bernard Casey, Castlevarney, Co. Monaghan emigrated aged 17 arriving Boston 1857 and his mother Ellen Murphy, Camlough, Co. Armagh met in USA and lived in Wisconsin where they reared their 10 boys + 6 girls. Fr. Solanus (Bernard Francis) was uneducated but through perseverance, discernment and faith he became a Capuchin Priest in 1904. He never heard confessions, preached on doctrinal issues or at major masses, never a P.P. but single never complained – His attitude was "I can't do everything, but I will do what I can". He held single roles in Friaries in New York, as sacristan, doorkeeper, and through this became a much loved counsellor. The sick sought his blessing and some remarkable cures took place. He prayed fervently. After 20 years in N.Y.C. he moved to St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit until 1945. He died in 1957.
