The Supreme Court Ruling last week upheld the Humphrey Judgement that the state must take into account the fact of pregnancy, if a person to be deported has an unborn child but that the unborn has no other Constitutional rights than the right to life, in Article 40.3.3. So if Article 40.3.3 is repealed, the unborn will have no other substantial constitutional rights.

The Irish Flag (Tri-colour)

This weekend marks the 170th anniversary of the flying at our flag by Francis Meagher at 33 The Mall, Waterford; (Mar 7th) to be exact. Meagher wrote at the time... "The White in the centre signifies a lasting truce between the Orange and the Green and I trust that beneath it folds the hands of the Irish Protestant and the Irish Catholic may be clasped in brotherhood. Meagher has a really interesting history which led him to fight on the losing side in Ireland, Australia + USA. He has a proud tradition in Montana where President Johnston in 1865 appointed him as the Secretary of the newly formed Montana Territory becoming its first Governor. The T.F. Foundation was founded in Ireland in 2013 by Rev. Michael Cavanagh and Senator Mark Daly and on Feb 23rd 2018 they established a permanent/ interactive exhibition on the history and place of the flag in the GPO in Dublin. The GPO is 200yrs old this year. Meagher's place in Irish + American history has now gained a more deserving degree of notoriety. I'm reading Timothy Egan's Book "The Immortal Irishman: The Irish Revolutionary who became an American hero" published in 2016. Thanks to my new found cousin Patrick Foley, Seattle + formerly Montana for the book.
