Reflection:

St. Patrick was an immigrant to Ireland. Like the Holy Family and many families today, he was an undocumented migrant, a refugee, a slave, a member of the diaspora and a returnee migrant. Yet, Patrick transcended all of these categories and became “One of Us”.

How did Patrick describe himself? A constant migrant? A restless slave? Someone trapped in his tribal identity? In his confessions, Patrick uses a phrase, ‘**The Desire of His Life**’ and he wants to share his desire with others. Patrick has experienced the Love of God, which was expressed in a Mission of Exile. Patrick is loved, blessed and called by God and he responds. His spirituality is practical, profound and prayerful....We listen to Patrick's own words from his confessions: **“In the knowledge of this faith in the Trinity, it is right to make known the gift of God and his eternal consolation. It is right to spread abroad the name of God, faithfully and without fear, to make known God's desire of love for each one of us...”**
