Congratulations

Magical Mona reclaims her national record at the Irish Open National Championships. Mona continued to work her magic in Dublin at the NAC last weekend. Mona, took 4 National titles (50 & 100 Breaststroke & 50 & 100 Freestyle) with a new Irish Senior Record in the 50m Freestyle (25.54sec). She also took silvers in her other 2 events. Mona also made the qualifying time for the European Senior Championships in Glasgow in early August and the qualifying time for the World Youth Olympics in Buenos Aires in early October. To cap off a great weekend she was awarded the 'swimmer of the meet'. Ireland's 50m Freestyle Irish Record was twice broken last Sunday on opposite sides of the world as Danielle Hill first and then Mona took hundredths of a second each from Mona's February standard of 25.60. Danielle Hill was swimming in the 50m Freestyle Final at the Commonwealth Games and touched in 25.56 for a new Irish record. However, 8 hours later, Mona won the 50m Freestyle in Dublin in 25.54, thus reclaiming and setting a new national record. Well done again Mona!
