Tensions between tribes had festered for years but eventually war broke out causing deaths of two million people and famine followed with 2000 children dying every day. It was massive news as we in Ireland had just entered the TV age. The response of the Churches was overwhelming, Protestant & Catholic alike. They flew in supplies from Sao Tome Island over a two year period, defying Nigerian jets, 16 aircraft made 5,500 trips ferrying 60,000 tonnes of relief, feeding 4 million people daily, and saving the lives of 1 million children. There was massive support by Irish people for the missionaires working in Nigeria. Many were arrested and expelled. For the good work and generosity of so many we remember with gratitude.
