~ Born in Mountcastle, Ballagh Parish. Educated at Summerhill College, Sligo + St. Patrick's College, Maynooth. He was ordained on 22nd June, 1958 in Maynooth. He served in Slough in Northamptonshire (1959-1964), Geevagh (1964-1965), St. Enda's College, Galway + U.C.G. (H.Dip.Ed. 1965-1966), Summerhill College (1966-1973), Strandhill (1973-1983), Adm. St. Anne's (1983-1989). Appointed Parish Priest St. Anne's, Sligo 1989 to July, 2015.

Retired in July 2015 and remains in St. Anne's as Pastor Emeritus. His brothers Fr. Peter S.P.S. and Fr. Tommy S.P.S. were ordained for the Kiltegan missionaries.
