**Michael Hargadon, Poet/ Athlete, Calry, Co. Sligo**

Like his contemporary, P. J. Gaynor – The Sligo Flyer – Hargadon would cycle to venues as far away as Manorhamilton, Boyle, Mohill and Carrick-on-Shannon, and then compete in his chosen events. At one meeting in Grange, Hargadon was exhausted after “riding a bad bicycle” from his home to the venue and did not have the energy to compete. However, Frazer revived him by producing “a half pint of whiskey” and giving him a few shots. Hargadon went on to win the high jump after Frazer’s invention pointing out to the stewards that they were keeping the rope slack for his opponent’s attempts but pulled it taut when Hargadon was jumping.
