6 New Saints in the Catholic Church

This Sun 14th Oct, Pope Francis will declare **Pope Paul VI, Blessed Oscar Romero, Fr. Francesco Spinelli, Fr. Vincent Romano, Mother Catherine Kasper, Nazaria Ignacia March Mesa** a saint at the Vatican during a meeting of the World Synod of Bishops.

Giovanni Montini (Pope Paul VI) as Pope, he brought Vatican II to a successful conclusion. One of his well-worn phrases was "There are only two things needed to become a saint – the grace of God and good-will" So get on with it. The miracle approved for his canonization involved the inexplicable healing of a baby in her mother's womb. On a visit to Brescia, Pope Paul's birthplace, the mother prayed to him for her child's recovery which contrary to all medical predictions, was complete. She gave birth to a healthy baby girl. A similar miracle was approved some years ago led to his beatification. Pope Paul VI (Giovanni Montini) born 1890 in Concesio, Italy died 1978 (the year of 3 Popes) Pope from 1963 – 1978.

Fr. Francesco Spinelli - Italy, founder of Sisters Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament.

Blessed Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador born 1917 murdered in San Salvador in 1980 for calling on the government to end violation of human rights.

Fr. Vincent Romano – who worked with the poor of Naples, died 1831.

Mother Catherine Kasper, German, founder of the religious congregation The Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ.

Nazaria Ignacia March Mesa, Spanish founder of the Congregation of the Missionary Crusaders of the Church. May these holy men + women be our protection, inspiration and guides. Amen.


