Includes flights, accomodation, 20kg Check-in luggage plus hand luggage, transfers and insurance. **Walking Details:** A minimum of 100km walk is required to obtain the "*Compostela*", the official accreditation of the pilgrimage of St. James. This year we will walk the **Celtic Camino**, which includes an Irish and Spanish Component. In Spain we will walk
