Aengus Lyons from Ballygawley went out with his friends to play a game of indoor football. Unfortunately, Aengus slipped and hit his head off a wall and snapped his spinal cord. He has spent the last four and a half years in the Mater Hospital, the National Rehabilitation Hospital and Sligo University Hospital. In July of this year he moved out of the hospital system and into Woodhaven Therapy Centre on the Strandhill Road. He is paralysed from the neck down and in a wheelchair. "Friends of Aengus" have started a fund to bring him home to Ballygawley and build a small purpose built house for him with a target of 50,000 euro.
