**St. Patrick's Day**

I am Patrick. I am the son of Calpornius. I was born in the year 390 on the west coast of England. At the age of sixteen, a band of pirates captured me and brought me to Ireland. I lived as a slave in Ireland for six years. My work at that time was on a sheep farm. It was lonely on the hillside and I prayed night and day that I would return safely to my own country. God heard my prayer and spoke to my heart but God also surprised me. He wrote the name of Ireland in my soul. Although I did return to my family, the voices of the Irish people kept ringing in my ears, calling me to come back. I returned to Ireland in 432 as a priest and I travelled to the remotest regions of your country where no Christian had ever been before. I baptised and I confirmed the Irish people. My message was simply this: *There is no other God except the God of Abraham, Isaac, Moses, the God of Israel, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. There never was any other God in times past and there will never be in the future.*
