North Sligo AC's Christopher O'Donnell retained his Irish Life Health national senior 400 metres title on Sunday in Santry in dramatic fashion. Christopher just pipped the fast-finishing Harry Purcell (Trim AC), who appeared to try and jump across the finish line in a desperate attempt to finish ahead of the Sligo man. Well done Christopher. North Sligo AC's Kieran Elliott (100m) reached the final of the men's 100m, but finished outside the medals. Best of luck to Christopher who has been selected to compete for Ireland in the 400 m and 4x 400m relay in the European Championships in Norway on 9-11 August.

Mona and Mouric McSharry star at the Irish Summer National Championships

Last week, Mona set another new Irish Senior Record in the 50m Butterfly final beating her previous record and setting a new record of 26.62. Competitors from Denmark and Germany all clocking in the 26 seconds proved no match for Mona in the end. Mona also took gold in the 50 m and the 100 m breaststroke and silver in the 50m and 100m front crawl. At 16 years of age, Mona's brother, Mouric achieved some SB (season best) times and finished a very creditable 8th in the 200 m breaststroke of the 17yr & older category.

Heritage Talk in aid of Northwest Simon Community

"Travelling along the Irish coast today we see here and there the remains of imposing monuments known as 'signal towers'. Four of these existed at one time on the Sligo coastline. Tourists and sightseers pass daily by Mullaghmore's Coast Road entirely oblivious of the important part the village once played in Britain's defences and the magnificent structure that formerly stood there.

What are signal towers and why were they built? And how did three entirely innocent local fishermen end up in the Tower of London in 1798 under sentence of death?

Come to the Beach Hotel in Mullaghmore on Sunday evening August 11th at 8.30 when local historian Joe Mc Gowan will present in words and images the story of the 'Mullaghmore Signal Tower and Sea Fencibles' and how three local fishermen became entangled in international intrigue.

Local artist Anna Mc Gloin was commissioned to do a painting of what the Signal Tower and environs would have looked like and this painting will also be unveiled on the evening. Admission is free but contributions at the door are invited and will be donated to the Northwest Simon Community."
