

### Heritage Talk in aid of Northwest Simon Community

“Travelling along the Irish coast today we see here and there the remains of imposing monuments known as ‘signal towers’. Four of these existed at one time on the Sligo coastline. Tourists and sightseers pass daily by Mullaghmore’s Coast Road entirely oblivious of the important part the village once played in Britain’s defences and the magnificent structure that formerly stood there.

What are signal towers and why were they built? And how did three entirely innocent local fishermen end up in the Tower of London in 1798 under sentence of death?

Come to the Beach Hotel in Mullaghmore on Sunday evening August 11<sup>th</sup> at 8.30 when local historian Joe Mc Gowan will present in words and images the story of the ‘Mullaghmore Signal Tower and Sea Fencibles’ and how three local fishermen became entangled in international intrigue.

Local artist Anna Mc Gloin was commissioned to do a painting of what the Signal Tower and environs would have looked like and this painting will also be unveiled on the evening. Admission is free but contributions at the door are invited and will be donated to the Northwest Simon Community.”
