Most recently the Connaught Finals took place at the ATU (previously IT Sligo) with great success for North Sligo AC. Our race walkers, Shane Dunleavy (U14) and Eabha Currid (U12) took gold and silver respectively. Sadhbh Ballantine qualified for nationals in the U13 Shot Putt and Emily Masterson and Anabelle Finn qualified for U11 girls relay. Hannah Waters and Emma Bruen took gold in U10 Turbo Javelin. Aoibhin Schmidtmeier (U14) took silver in the shot putt and Daniel Murray (U14) took silver in the hurdles. Jasmine Dunleavy (U17) took bronze in the long jump. Ann Currid (U17) took bronze in 200m, Ciara Schmidtmeier (U11) silver in 60m and and Laina McCormack (U11) in 600m. Darragh McGee won U16 Gold over 800m and will compete at the Nationals in Tullamore on 2nd July. Bruce Philips and Shay Davis finished 4 th qualifying for the Nationals in 100m, 200m and 1500m respectively. Our clubs Masters Men's team put in a very impressive performance in the National Masters 10k over 35 championship in the Phoenix Park in April. The team of Donal Egan, Craig Brennan, Eamon McAndrew, Eamon Murphy and Alan Wallace overcame tough competition to finish 2nd . Eamon Murphy was very impressive in winning the Masters 3k at the Connacht championships in Athlone recently

We are particularly proud of Christopher O'Donnell who has represented North Sligo AC and Ireland at national and international level for several years now. He will compete to regain his national title in the 400m this weekend and we wish him every success. The 400m heats take place on Saturday, 25 June at 17.30 and the Final is on Sunday, 26 June at 19.25. You will be able to see the final on RTE 2 from 6pm on Sunday 26th. Christopher achieved a PB (personal best) last week in Madrid, running the 400m in 45.26 seconds. He has the 5th fastest time in Europe for 2022 so far. Christopher has now secured automatic qualification to the European Championship's in Munich this August. We wish Christopher every success.
