The Catholic Church throughout the world and in Ireland is beginning a series of conversations about what God wants of his people at this time, often referred to as a Synodal Process, coming from a Greek word which means “walking together”. On Sunday 17th October we mark the opening of this entitled, ‘For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission’. This coincides with the start of the two-year Synodal Pathway for the Catholic Church in Ireland which will lead, in time, to a National Synodal Assembly in Ireland. Here in Elphin, Bishop Kevin will lead an hour of prayerful reflection at St Patrick’s Church, Strandhill on Sunday 17th October at 4.00pm. This will include readings, music and a time of adoration.
