### DISASTER IN SLIGO BAY

#### THREE MEN DROWNED; THREE SAVED IN BOATING TRAGEDY

*The men were lost when their boat was overturned by a freak wave in the vicinity of Blackrock Lighthouse as they attempted to reach a stranded boat early on Sunday morning.*

Lost in the tragedy were-

**James Leydon**, 58, principal Lightkeeper of Eagle Island, Co Mayo

**Michael McLoughlin**, 24, a seaman who, it was understood, was to be married in the autumn and was to join a vessel of the Irish Shipping Ltd fleet in Hamburg this week; and

**Michael Kilgallon**, 25, a former seaman who had returned to Rosses Point about a year ago and had taken up farming.
