Chairperson's Report: It is with great sadness that I write this year's Annual Report as we have recently lost two great supporters of Cliffoney – Paddy Wallace and Anne Hoey who have both passed in recent months. Paddy was a great keen supporter of our efforts in Tiny Towns and could always be relied upon for a helping hand by the many community groups and activities in Cliffoney.
