**Witness Walk – Meeting Heaven at Harvest Time Wednesday**, August 21st at 6.45pm from the Apparition Chapel. Journey back in time to the evening of Thursday, August 21st, 1879. Together we will meet each of the witnesses as they journey from their homesteads in the village and make their way to the gable wall of the Parish Church, the site of the Apparition. We will conclude at the Apparition Chapel.
