News from Mynamar (Burma) - The first Columban missionary.

Fr Francis Xavier La Aung Nbwi was ordained on 1st May 2024. Born in the Kachin State of Mynamar, The Columban's worked in Mynamar from 1936 – 1979 in the State of Kachin among the tribal people of Northern Burma bringing the Catholic faith with the help of 38 Columban Priests.

Burma was one of the richest countries in Asia in the 1950's, exporting rice, jade, gold, rubber & teak wood. Now it is one of the poorest due in large to the takeover in 1964 by the military-socialist government. They nationalized all the schools and hospitals and in 1966 ordered all missionaries to leave the country. By 1969 when the last Columbans has left the country there were five indigenous priests. After the absence of over 30 years, the Columbans finally reentered Burma in 2015 with a new team of missionary priests and lay missionaries and began to serve the Kachin people again. The Columban Sisters returned in 2003. The political situation is continually on a knife edge. But we rejoice that one of those Kachin people has been ordained a Columban Missionary.

Salmon Run has dried up! – Inland Fisheries Ireland has recently shown there has been a dramatic depletion in the number of salmon in Irish rivers and lakes in the past 20 years; dropping by 90%. Some of the decline is caused by the seas getting warmer and fish such as salmon moving further north to rivers in Norway and Iceland. Plastic is now seen as the great threat to our seas. Around 400 million tonnes is discharged every year in the seas. The collapse of our oceans will spell disaster for all life on the planet. The well being of our seas is not high on the agenda in either media or parliament. Pope Francis highlighted all this in his encyclical "Laudati Si: on care of our common home."
