On April 27, 2025, on the Jubilee for Young People, Pope Francis will elevate to the honors of the altars Carlo Acutis, who died aged 15 in Monza, Italy, in 2006. His mother, Antonia Salzano Acutis, has been attempting to answer the questions many are asking her: What is her son's secret? Why is a boy like so many others, who died very young, invoked throughout the world? | Carlo is "the saint you do not expect. He lived in a social environment like that of many young people of his time. He also loved what young people in general do. [...] His purpose [was] to make something beautiful of himself for God." What is "the beautiful"? "What will truly make us beautiful in God's eyes will be how we have loved him and how we have loved our brothers and sisters." | I met with one of the witnesses who knew Carlo two years before his death. It was Father Roberto Gazzaniga, now almost an octogenarian, the spiritual father of the Leone XIII high school in Milan. The student was 14 years old and, after middle school, had enrolled in the classical high school. The characteristics the Jesuit ascribed to him are significant: "He was a good boy; he had a stately bearing because he belonged to a wealthy family, but he was a 'gentleman' in the most meaningful sense of the term. This was not only in the way he behaved, in his relationships, in his generosity, but in everything, even the most ordinary situations. From the earliest days of school Carlo distinguished himself by the gentleness and discretion with which he noticed those who were in difficulty, those who were struggling to integrate into the class, and approached them with simplicity, trying to overcome their reluctance to communicate.
