

St Augustine of Hippo 354 -430AD

Born in Thagaste in Africa of a Berber family. He was brought up a Christian but left the church early and spent a deal of time seriously seeking the truth until at length through the prayers of his mother St Monica and the teaching of St Ambrose of Milan, he was converted back to Christianity & baptized in 387, shortly before his mother's death. Augustine has a brilliant legal & academic year, but after his conversion he returned home to Africa & led an ascetic life. He was elected bishop of Hippo & spent 34 years looking after his flock, teaching & strengthening them in the faith & protecting then against the errors of the time. He wrote an enormous amount & left a permanent mark on both philosophy & theology. His most notable work "Confessions" is dazzling in style & deep in content.

The Augustines – the order of priests, brothers & sisters which Pope Leo XIV was a member and the Prior General for 12 years was founded on the inspiration of St Augustine. They have a church in Galway city, Limerick city, Cork & Dublin.
