Laudato Si - Back in 1891, the last Pope Leo (Leo XIII) wrote an encyclical letter called *Rerum Novarum* ("Concerning New Things") which is generally regarded as the foundational document of the Social Doctrine of the Church. From that time forward most of the Popes have added their own teaching on the key social challenges of the time: the rights and responsibilities of workers and employers; government and the common good; the ownership and use of property; war and peace; integral development and justice. Just ten years ago, in 2015, Pope Francis surprised us with his encyclical letter *Laudato Si*. Francis invites us to see ourselves as having been entrusted, by a loving Creator, with the earth as our common home. He asks us to live on the earth with a spirit of reverence and gratitude. Time and again Francis reminds us that everything is connected and what is called for is an "integral ecology". As we protect vegetation and marine ecosystems, public spaces and human embryos, we build a network of relationships in which the goods of the earth are more justly distributed. The protection of non-renewable resources is a matter of justice, both across the nations of the earth today and also toward generations as yet unborn. The environment tends to be seen as a crisis in a negative sense, but we Christians always need to approach crisis with an attitude of Christian Hope. In this Jubilee Year of Hope, the Partners in the Gospel invite parishioners across our two Dioceses to participate in a series of three workshops under the general title "Sowing Seeds of Hope" in which we can explore some of the richness of *Laudato Si*. I invite you to join us and to share your own wisdom and experience.

Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991 – 2006), located in yet another church dedicated to Mary at Santa Maria Maggiore. The story of Carlo Acutis – variously called a "saint of our times" or the "the teenage saint2 – is a fascinating one. He was born in London to Italian parents, who soon moved the family back to Italy, where the young Carlo grew up and was consumed with two passions – Jesus and the Internet. He became well known as a "computer geek" and a catechist. He combined them by launching a Catholic website in 2004. The initiative culminated in an exhibition unveiled on 4th October 2006, the feast of St Francis of Assisi – just 10 days before Carlo himself tragically died from leukaemia. Beatified in 2020, his canonisation was planned for 27th April 2025 but had to be postponed due to the death of Pope Francis. The Canonization will take place on the 7th September 2025.

On YOU TUBE find "HIKING TO FIND PIER GLOREIO FRASSATI" the young mass from Turin who died aged 24 and will be canonized a saint on Sept 7th in Rome along with Blessed Carlo Acutis.
