This year, a delegation of the Silver Reader Motoclub, the motorcycle club par excellence of Spain, presided by the great RTVE writer, traveler, director of adventure documentaries as <<Diary of a Nomad>> for Miquel Silvestre and one of the pioneers in giving visibility to the epic of the shipwreck Francisco de Cuéllar in Spain will be joining us in the tributes we performed in Sligo to the shipwrecks of the Navy in 1588.

Canonization in Rome Sept 7th 2025 – Carlo Acutis & Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized on Sunday at a ceremony in the Vatican presided over by Pope Leo XIV. The Pope made the Announcement that these young men 16 & 24 yrs of age from different eras who led completely different lives but who are united in their love for Christ and their ability to impart that love to those whose lives they touched. 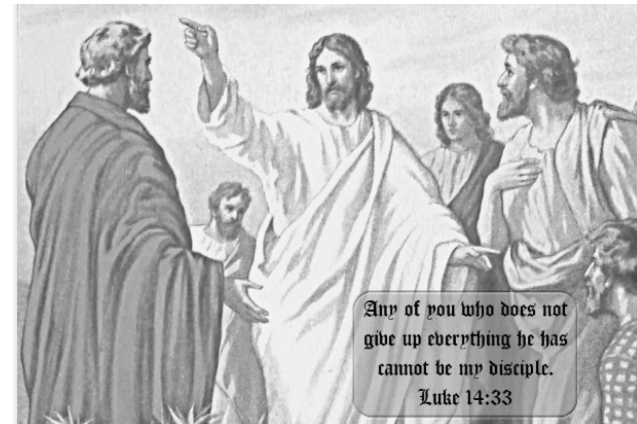
