Christopher's athletics began initially with Benbulbin FC and with North Sligo Athletic Club. Assisted by local trainers, he found his niche at the 100m and the 4 X 100m relay and his career took off in 2014. He has been all over the world competing at the highest level: Tokyo Olympic Games 2020 and Paris in 2024 and the European Championships in Rome where his Team won gold in the mixed 4 X 400 meters relay team.
