Proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV on the occasion of the eight centenary of the death of St Francis of Assisi. Born 1181 died 1226. Founder of the Franciscan Order. An Italian mystic & poet. Inspired to live a life of poverty, he left his wealthy family to become a beggar and itinerant preacher. Watch the film “Brother Sun, Sister Moon” by Franco Zeffirelli’s. A classic on the life of St Francis.

During this time of grace, the faithful are granted the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence. Until Jan 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain this grace under the usual conditions, Sacramental Confession, Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Pope, by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St Francis anywhere in the world. Furthermore, the elderly, the sick and those for serious reasons, cannot leave their homes can obtain the plenary indulgence by spiritually joining in the jubilee celebrations & offering their prayers, pains or sufferings to God. - Oct 4th is the feast day of St Francis of Assisi, annually and is now a worldwide day to celebrate & bless our pets, as St Francis is patron saint of animals, the environment and ecology.
