Pope Leo's Third Pastoral Journey - starts next week in Algiers, Cameroon, Angola & Equatorial Guinea. A 10-day pilgrimage and a statement of priorities. Leo served as prior general of the Augustinians for 12 years. This pilgrimage brings him to the homeland of Augustine of Hippo. **Algiers:** mainly Muslim country where Catholics have to live alongside us as a minority.

Cameroon: A country divided by English & French languages & the left overs of colonialism. Massive invisibility and division. Fr. Franklin at Sligo Cathedral and Fr. Conrad at St. Anne's, Sligo are our two priests from Cameroon, Deo Gratius.

Angola: Former Portuguese colony. Rich in oil & natural resources, yet bearing the scars of civil war 70% Catholic. The discovery of oil often leads to displacement of the poor and the degradation of the law.

Equatorial Guinea: A Spanish colony, 70% Catholic. Rich in oil but mainly population very poor and living under authoritarian leadership.

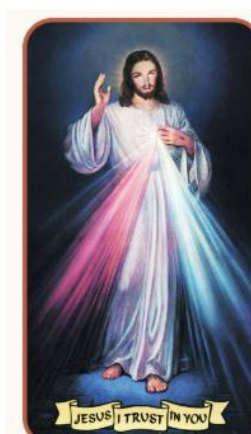
