Have your Say – Speed Limits in our Village
Submission Deadline: 4th September 2026

Following Cliffoney Community Meeting, we want your input on important speed limit measures to help make our village safer for everyone – especially our children.

1. Introduce **30kph** limit in village to replace existing **50kph**.
2. No periodic speed limits at School. Children are our & about in village at all hours of the day.
3. Buffer zone speed limits on each side of village reduced from **80kph** to at least **60** if not 50kph.
4. **Speed ramps** needed at both ends of village on N15.
5. **Fixed speed cameras** in village.
6. **30kph** on Mullaghmore road as far as Soccer pitch. **50 or 60kph** rest of way to Mullaghmore.
7. **30kph** on Ballintrillick road as far as end of houses with **50kph** buffer zone for next 300m.
8. **Garda** enforcement / presence / visibility more often.

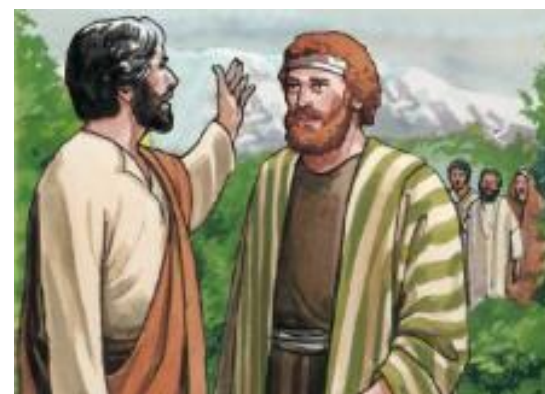
